SINGERS, BEWARE

CHOOSING THE RIGHT SUMMER PROGRAM

During my undergraduate years, I had the honor of being selected for the 40-voice Westminster Choir, then the chorus-in-residence at the Spoleto Festival USA (formerly also known as the Festival of Two Worlds). Those three summers were priceless. Not only was I a member of one of the world's premier choirs, but I had the unusual opportunity to interact with some of the burgeoning professionals of the time. Our chorus master, Glenn Parker, was a genuinely fun person. He was also a demanding taskmaster who expected no less than our best because on stage we would be conducted by the likes of Cristian Badea and the late Spiros Argiris.

We would also interact with Renée Fleming before she made her Metropolitan Opera debut; the tenor Franco Farina; the bass Victor von Halem and Anthony Laciura, who would become one of the Met's best-loved character tenors and an acclaimed actor in the television series *Boardwalk Empire*.

Most importantly, we would work with the festival's founder, Gian Carlo Menotti, on his own opera, *The Saint of Bleeker Street*, and in productions of *Parsifal* and *Jenufa*. Spoleto did what a summer program should do; inspire, educate and convey what it takes to become an operatic artist of the first water.

A year after my last Spoleto experience, which, among other things, strengthened my grasp of the Italian language, I was accepted as an apprentice and later a fellow at the Aspen Music Festival and School. I played three lead roles during those summers and got to hone my craft through first-rate coaching, masterclasses, and performances under the leadership of Edward Berkeley, Jorge Mester, John DeMain and others. The eminent cellist Lynn Harrell, whose father Mack Harrell was a Metropolitan Opera baritone, exhibited a better legato than most singers. During my third year, a young cellist came to me and said that Mr. Harrell wanted help with phrasing

and breathing in the Schumann Concerto. My summer experiences kept getting better!

I was also enrolled in my share of pyramid schemes designed mainly to line the pockets of the organizers, who bribed government officials in small European villages. Fees were usually exorbitant and the instruction, mediocre. And yet, during one such otherwise poor experience, I met a voice teacher outside of the program who would change my vocal life. She gave me tools that continue to serve me as both singer and teacher.

Thirty years ago, when I applied for these programs, the number of singers pursuing opera was small by today's standards. I often encountered the same singers at auditions in North America and in Europe. Today, it would be a miracle if two singers should encounter each other at more than one audition venue. The field is saturated. Many young singers are not ready.

Saturation at the "aspiring" level creates a demand for more summer training programs. The majority of programs during my formative years were bona fide training programs. Often philanthropies lowered the financial burden on participants. The schemes that are rampant today reflect the desperation of young singers who need to fill their résumés and validate their applications for more reputable programs. It is difficult to convince young singers that it is their well-rounded talents that get them to be seriously considered. And yet it is possible that a young student will meet his or her next mentor even in the context of a predatory program.

The summer experience is still relevant. I advise even my professional clients to find inspiring environments to prepare their next role, whether visiting a coach in some idyllic village or a teacher who lives in an interesting town they have never been to. A good summer program should: 1) place the young artist in a safe, unfamiliar, inspiring environment in

which he/she can explore the unexpected; 2) provide a curriculum that challenges all aspects of the student's craft; 3) offer enough performing experiences to allow students to put new discoveries into practice 4) include a faculty of educators who spend their time helping singers grow.

Too much stress is put on masterclasses with famous singers. Some are good at it, most are not. Teaching is a skill that takes years to develop. Singing and the teaching of singing are different disciplines that require different skill sets. Few people have both at the highest level. A singer may have a great technique and no idea how to communicate to the student how to acquire those skills. A singer may be a great interpreter and have no idea how to convey this insight. While it is cool to hang out with famous people, is it worth thousands of dollars to find out if they can teach?

Not that I am against famous singers. If I find a big name with great teaching skills (such as Joyce DiDonato) I would do everything possible to have this person at my summer academy. On the other hand, it is inspiring to have high-level active performers give concerts and talk about their experiences. I have had lunch, coffee or dinner with top singers, conductors and directors when I was in my twenties. Their insights remain with me today.

We go to summer programs to learn what we need to improve, to uncover another piece of our true selves, to be inspired to go beyond our comfort zones. To the aspiring young singer I say the following: beware of any program that promises to fix all of your problems and pave the way to your big break. That is pure fantasy. If you wish truly to take advantage of the summer program atmosphere, do some research, contact the programs and talk to friends who may have attended. Make sure that you are getting what you expect. Summer programs should get you closer to your dream, not create a mirage of your favourite operatic stage. **LSM**

CAMPS D'ÉTÉ ARTISTIQUES

QUÉBEC

MUSÉE D'ART CONTEMPORAIN (MONTRÉAL)

C'est l'artiste Rafael Lozano-Hemmer qui est à l'honneur au camp d'été du MAC cette année. L'expert des nouveaux médias joint habilement l'art et les technologies. Le camp propose une foule d'activités stimulantes en arts plastiques et numériques autour des œuvres de l'artiste : transfert d'images, projection lumineuse, peinture acrylique, collage, sculpture par assemblage et sérigraphie sur t-shirt.

ÉCOLE DE DANSE DU QUÉBEC (QUÉBEC)

L'EDQ offre un camp d'été non seulement pour les jeunes, mais aussi pour les adultes ! En effet, les grands peuvent s'inscrire à un bloc de quatre semaines et choisir leur style : contemporain, ballet, jazz et, nouvellement cette année, la méthode Feldenkrais. Pianistes et percussionnistes sur place pour enrichir l'expérience.

ORFORD MUSIQUE (ORFORD)

Encore cette année, l'Académie réserve aux musiciens un stage riche et varié. Chacun y trouve son compte : instruments d'orchestre, piano, voix, guitare et composition. On y aborde entre autres la musique de chambre, la musique baroque, l'improvisation et la musique contemporaine, en passant par la philosophie et la psychologie du musicien.

DOMAINE FORGET (SAINT-IRÉNÉE)

La liste des stages offerts se diversifie encore à l'Académie du Domaine Forget : bois, cuivres, guitare, chant, accompagnement

vocal, chorale, piano solo, piano d'accompagnement, piano solo et ensemble, musique de chambre, cordes, ensemble à cordes, composition, danse et, nouvellement cette année, direction d'orchestre. Enseignement de qualité assuré par des professeurs chevronnés.

ÉCOLE D'ÉTÉ DE CHANT CHORAL (SHERBROOKE)

Cette année, chefs de chœur et choristes se réunissent autour des œuvres sacrées d'Arvo Pärt et Henryk Gorecki. L'École d'été aura lieu au campus principal de l'Université de Sherbrooke. Les activités se tiendront au nouveau pavillon de pointe de l'École de musique et le concert de clôture aura lieu à la magnifique Abbaye Saint-Benoît-du-Lac.

CAMP MUSICAL PÈRE LINDSAY (SAINT-CÔME)

Toutes les sessions de l'été 2018 sont déjà complètes ! Toutefois, il reste encore quelques places aux sessions de formation pour adultes. Un camp en violoncelle et contrebasse ainsi qu'un camp en percussions s'ajoutent cette année à celui de piano. Séjours d'une à cinq nuitées selon le camp choisi.

CAMP TUTTI (LENNOXVILLE)

Ce camp musical d'une semaine privilégie une approche intergénérationnelle. Les participants de tous âges et tous niveaux travaillent ensemble dans un univers trilingue (français, anglais et russe). Le camp se déroule dans les locaux de la faculté de musique de l'Université Bishop's. Le programme de huit jours semble trop contraignant ? Grâce au nouveau séjour flexible, vous pouvez choisir les jours que vous préférez.

LAMBDA MUSIC SUMMER DAY CAMP (PIERREFONDS)

Voici un camp anglophone uniquement dédié au piano. Il vise les enfants de six ans et plus de tous les niveaux. Chaque jour, les jeunes pratiquent le piano, apprennent l'histoire de la musique et développent leur oreille et la rythmique. Pour les élèves plus avancés, des cours de maîtres et cours individuels sont offerts sur demande. Les plus grands sont aussi les bienvenus durant les deux fins de semaine d'ateliers pour adultes de tous les niveaux.

CAMMAC (HARRINGTON)




